Pre-Registration: In order to support the efficient organisation of the competitions, it is very important that National Federations register participants to the competitions as early as possible.

Deadline: The deadline for registration is 15 days before the first day of competition (the “Registration Date”) on 24th November 2022 at 11:59 PM Hong Kong Time (UTC+8)

Registration Fee: The registration fee is US\$60 per athlete, and it will be collected during confirmation of attendance in cash only.

***All athletes are compulsory to participate all disciplines.**

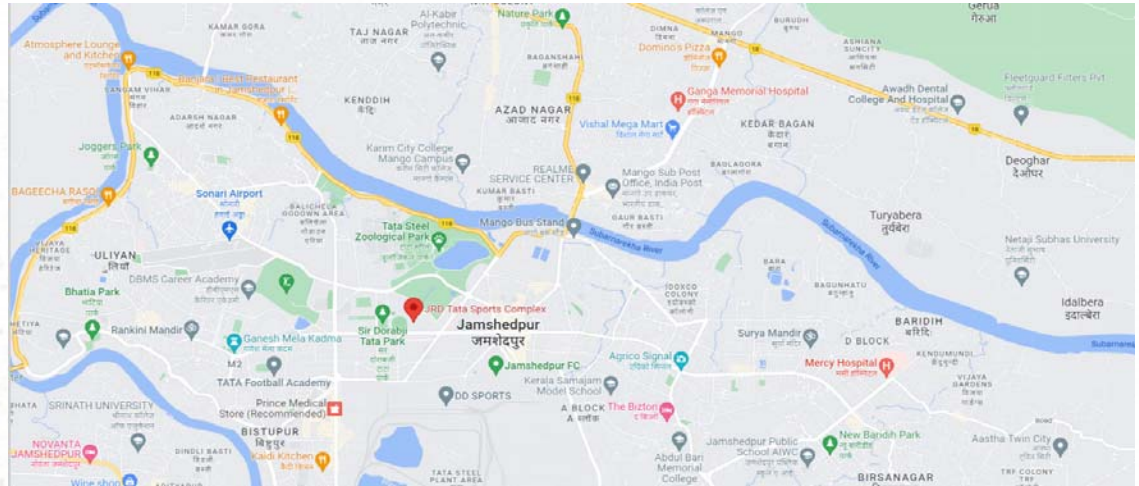

11. ASIAN K CHAMPIONSHIP RULES

1. INTRODUCTION

- 1.1. IFSC-ACC K-Championship (known as Asian K-Championship) competition shall be organized every year.
- 1.2. Each Asian K-Championship competition approved by the IFSC-ACC shall include both Boys and Girls Categories and shall include events in all three Disciplines and Combined event.
- 1.3. Asian K-Championship competitions shall normally take place during weekend periods. The maximum duration of a K-Championship competition shall be 3 (three) days. Special consideration shall be given to determining the dates of such competitions in order to minimize problems associated with attendance at educational institutions.
- 1.4. IFSC-ACC will ensure that any text or image materials display relating to Asian K-Championship are designed and planned properly.
- 1.5. All Athletes are mandatory to participate in all disciplines.

2. ELIGIBILITY

- 2.1. Only Asian country citizen competitors who hold a valid national identification card or Asian passport shall be eligible to compete in Asian K-Championship competition.
- 2.2. The Asian K-Championship shall include the following Age Groups:
 - i. Youth C (U14): competitors eligible to register for this Age Group shall have been born either 12 (twelve) or 13 (thirteen) calendar years before the year of the competition.
 - ii. Youth D (U12): competitors eligible to register for this Age Group shall have been born either 10 (ten) or 11 (eleven) calendar years before the year of the competition.

3. FORMAT AND RULES

3.1. The format of each event in Asian K-Championship competition shall be as set out in the relevant Section, Part 2 – Discipline rules, of IFSC Rules with modification with the following articles:

3.2. In Lead event, competitions shall be organized with Qualification round and Final round.

i. Qualification Round:

a. Starting Order:

Same as the Speed event when 1 (one) starting group is used.

b. Format:

Group Youth C: 2 (two) Routes in Lead flash format.

Group Youth D: 2 (two) Routes in Top-roped flash format, in order to finish the route, the competitor need to hold the end hold with both hands.

ii. Climbing Time:

5 minutes for both qualification and final rounds.

3.3. In Speed event, competitions shall be organized with Qualification round and Final round.

i. Qualification Round:

a. Starting Order:

Same as the Lead event when 1 (one) starting group is used for the Lead event.

ii. Final Round:

a. Each stage (e.g. quarter final, semifinal) shall be completed for same Age Group and Categories before the start of the next stage.

iii. Fault Start:

Both competitors will not be stopped but the fault started competitor will be eliminated.

3.4. In Boulder event, competitions shall be organized with Qualification round and Final round.

i. Qualification Round Flash Format:

a. Minimum 5 (five) boulders for each age group and category. Only under special situations, Jury President can cancel 1 (one) boulder with consent from Technical Delegate.

b. Only 1 (one) starting group is applied for each age group and category.

c. There shall be no isolation and no fixed starting order.

d. Each competitor shall choose their own sequence to attempt the boulders.



- e. They make a physical queue for each boulder and must submit the score card to the Boulder Judge before making any attempt.
- f. Only one attempt, with a maximum of 2 (two) minutes, is allowed for each time.
- g. Competition Time = Number of competitors x 2 (two) minutes
- h. Technical Incident:
 - 1) Can be resolved within 5 (five) minutes: No time compensation is needed
 - 2) Cannot be resolved within 5 (five) minutes: Then this boulder result shall be cancelled.
- i. All competitors shall be under isolation condition during their attempts.
- j. Appeal if upheld would entitle the affected competitor(s) to make attempts on the relevant boulder(s) should be made immediately.

3.5. In Combined Event, competitions shall be organized with Final round.

- i. Top 8 finalists are determined by calculating the Combined Ranking from the General Ranking in each of the Speed, Boulder and Lead Disciplines.
- ii. Ranking for combined shall be calculated following the conclusion in all three disciplines as follows:

Overall Ranking = Speed Rank x Bouldering Rank x Lead Rank

4. REGISTRATION OF TEAM

4.1. OFFICIALS

- i. Member federations may register, within statutory deadlines, all their team officials who shall be granted free entry into the competition venue.
 - a. 1 (one) head of delegation;
 - b. Maximum 3 (three) nationally/internationally certified climbing coaches;
 - c. Maximum 3 (three) nationally certified/internationally medical or para-medical personnel.
- ii. Maximum of 2 (two) team officials can enter the isolation zone.
- iii. Maximum of 2 (two) team officials can enter the competition zone, without disturbing the running of the competition, for appeal purpose.



4.2. ATHLETES

- i. ACC Member Federations
20 (Twenty) competitors in each Category in each Age Group.
- ii. Non-ACC Member Federations
10 (Ten) competitors in each Category in each Age Group, but they need to register through their National Federation.

5. CONFIRMATION OF PARTICIPATION

- 5.1. by the attendance of at least one team official (or one competitor if no Team Officials are registered) at the registration venue before the Technical Meeting; or
- 5.2. In exceptional circumstances only (e.g. strikes, traffic/flight delay, etc.), by SMS or email, which is listed in the information sheet, to the Technical Delegate or Jury President, in each case not later than the date(s) and time(s) specified on the information sheet published.

6. ANTI-DOPING

No Anti-doping tests to be carried out

7. MEDAL AND PRIZES

- 7.1. Gold/Silver/Bronze medals shall be awarded to the competitors respectively ranked 1st, 2nd and 3rd. For the avoidance of doubt, multiple medals will be awarded where competitors are tied.
- 7.2. Organizer could give the prize to the winners in kind of material (climbing equipment, bags, and the like). Prize money in cash or other kind do not allow.
- 7.3. Organizer must present certificates for the winners, all competitors and Team Officials.

8. CEREMONIES

- 8.1. Unless specifically authorized by the Jury President, at least one team member from each team must attend the opening ceremony.
- 8.2. The Event Organizer shall organize an award ceremony to follow the conclusion of the final rounds. Unless specifically authorized by the Jury President, the top 3 (three) finalists in each Category, Age Group and Discipline shall attend the award ceremony.
- 8.3. Flag rising and National anthem will not be taken place.
