REGISTRATION

Zones to select 3 climbers in each discipline as per their respective category. Thus, maximum participants in all categories should not exceed 30. Zones to appoint one Coach & one Manager along with the team.

HOW TO GET TO BENGALURU

BY AIR

Nearest Airport is the Kempegowda International Airport.

Bangalore is well-connected by regular flights from all the important cities in India and also has international carriers flowing in and out of the Bengaluru International Airport, which is located about 40 kilometers from the main city. A taxi from the airport would take about 45 minutes to reach the city.

BY TRAIN

Bangalore has two important railway stations KSR City Railway Station & Yeswantpur Junction. Both railway stations have regular trains running from Delhi, Mumbai, Pune and other major cities. For travelling within Bangalore, there is Namma Metro with direct connectivity from Railway Station & Bus Station to the Competition Venue by the Bangalore Metro Rail Corporation.

ACCOMMODATION

Participants to organize their own accommodation. However if the zones require dormitory, the organisers will provide the same on the request of respective zones.
