Hanifl Centre conducts WFA, WAFA, WFR and CPR courses in India. The course content for each course and Scope of Practice (SoP) for courses are regularly updated by Aerie under the umbrella of the Wilderness Medicine Society (that sets standards in the US). In addition, Aerie collaborates and consults with WMI-NOLS and other providers of wilderness medicine training in the US to stay abreast of the latest research in this field. The curriculum being taught is evidence based and vetted on a regular basis. Aerie-Hanifl instructors are professional care providers with many years of outdoor leadership experience.

Course Description

Wilderness Advanced First Aid (WAFA) course is designed for outdoor professionals and outdoor enthusiasts, preparing them to care of injuries and illness in remote, challenging environments. The course is fast-paced, challenging, hands-on and fun.

This internationally recognised Wilderness Advanced First Aid (WAFA) course addresses injury and illness prevention, patient assessment, long-term patient management, improvised splint and litter construction, and environmental emergencies while stressing the

thought processes unique to caring for patients in remote environments.
